Haifa House for Holocaust Survivors

The International Christian Embassy Jerusalem partnered with the organization Yad Ezer L'Chaver and Director Shimon Sabag in January to expand the home by purchasing and renovating a four-story building next door.

We would like to make you aware of a new opportunity with the Holocaust Home. A building with three floors on the same street has now been offered to Yad Ezer for the very reasonable price of 250,000 Euros. It could house another 50 survivors from the current waiting list of over 1,800.



ICEJ AID is asking all our friends and supporters worldwide to give generously to this worthy project. It is our hope to be able to present a check for this second building at the grand opening of the newly refurbished home in September in the presence of the President and Prime Minister of Israel.
